3) You will be emailed when your item is safely in OBON SOCIETY possession.

4) **We will notify you when the family is found.** If you don't hear from us it means the search is underway. This is meticulous work so we appreciate your patience.

The Yosegaki Hinomaru you have is more than 70 years old; the fabric is fragile, please handle with care.

If you would like to send a short message to the family in Japan, please include it with the flag. We will translate your letter into Japanese and pass your thoughts on to the family in Japan whenever possible.

- 1) Fold the flag gently along the existing creases and place it inside a heavy plastic bag (zip-loc type) for protection against moisture.
- 2) Place this inside a well-padded envelope or rigid cardboard envelope (used for mailing books.) You might consider mailing it certified, for added protection.
- 3) Enclose this form with the flag and mail it to **OBON SOCIETY**. (We appreciate an email alerting us the day you put this in the mail so we can watch for its arrival.)
